

## Water Resource Management (WRM)

### PG Diploma and Masters Part I Course Selection



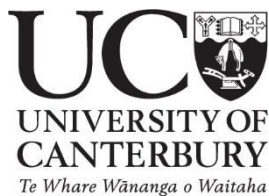
These degrees can be taken through either Lincoln or Canterbury University, and you should choose your courses as indicated below, depending on the university you have enrolled through. To complete the PG Diploma WRM or Masters WRM Part I programme, you will need a total of at least **120 points** (you can get dispensation to graduate with 115 points if you end up slightly short). Further information on individual courses is available on both university websites, and at [www.waterways.ac.nz](http://www.waterways.ac.nz) for the 'WATR' prefix courses.



**Compulsory courses:** WATR 601, WATR 602, WATR 603 (all 20 pts each)

**Plus:** At least 30 points from; LWST 602, MAST 603, ERST 621, ERST 630, ERST 632, ERST 633, ECON 606 (all 20 pts each). You may also choose from U Canterbury courses: GEOG 404 (30 pts) or ENVR 410 (15 pts) if you wish.

**Plus:** Another course (if needed) from 600-level courses at Lincoln University, to form a coherent programme of water management-relevant study. ***It is highly recommended that you take WATR 605 (20 pts) if you have not previously undertaken research.***



**Compulsory courses:** WATR 401, WATR 402, WATR 403 (all 15 pts each)

**Plus:** At least 30 points from GEOG 404 (30 pts) and ENVR 410 (15 pts), and from LWST 602, MAST 603, ERST 621, ERST 630, ERST 632, ERST 633, ECON 606 (all 20 pts each) offered through Lincoln University.

**Plus:** Another course (if needed) from 400-level courses at University Canterbury to form a coherent programme of water management-relevant study. ***It is highly recommended that you take WATR 405 (15 pts) if you have not previously undertaken research***
